#### Depression in Older Adults-May 15-6 pm

Adults 65 and older are more likely to experience difficulties with health issues, loss and grief, memory problems, and isolation all of which contribute to feeling of sadness. Felling of sadness can be a sign of depression, so often not recognized in older population. Dr, Nicholas Schor will be speaking about depression in older adults and how to recognize the symptoms. He will also answer your questions about depression. Dr Schor is a board certified psychiatrist.
