Special Tour of Building Museum Exhibition Small Stories and Cool Off with a Visit to Special Exhibition-Icebergs! Enjoy Coffee in the Corinthian Lounge-July 15

The National Building Museum, is offering us a very special day at the museum on Friday, July 15 starting at 10 am! They have scheduled a special viewing of Small Stories: At Home in a Doll House. Small Stories reveals the fascinating tales behind some of London's Victoria & Albert Museum of Childhood's best-loved doll houses, taking you on a journey through the history of the home, everyday lives, and changing family relationships.

Following this tour, we will be able to stop in and visit the museum's special summer exhibition, Icebergs! Representing a beautiful, underwater world of glacial ice fields spanning the Museum's enormous Great Hall, the immersive installation will emphasize current themes of landscape representation, geometry, and construction. ICEBERGS will feature installation elements in a variety of sizes and built of re-usable construction materials such as scaffolding and polycarbonate paneling, a material commonly used in building greenhouses. A "water line" suspended 20 feet high will bisect the vertical space, allowing panoramic views from high above the ocean surface and down below among the towering bergs ICEBERGS will occupy a total area of 12,540 square feet. Icebergs is designed by James Corner Field Operations, an urban design, landscape architecture, and public realm practice based in New York City and known for projects such as New York's High Line and Santa Monica's Tongva Park.
