#### Summary of 2015 Volunteer Survey Results

On October 2, we released an electronic survey to 57 volunteers, we experienced a 53% response rate. The majority of the respondents volunteer 1 to 3 times per month. 86% of them were very satisfied with their volunteer experience and 14% were satisfied. Volunteers stated that what they enjoy most about volunteering for GV is; "Opportunity to meet interesting people", "Opportunity to help", "I have met some amazing people I would never have met", "I feel as though I have received much more than I have given. The folks that I have helped are so thankful and gracious. It has been a pleasure", "Meeting and helping the wonderful people in our community".

These are only some of the wonderful statements we received from our enthusiastic volunteers, please don't hesitate to ask for help, as you can see from the above statements, our volunteers truly enjoy meeting and helping our members!

Georgetown Village wants our members to be aware of the following concerns:

Package theft is a common problem in our area. Here are some tips to help prevent your packages from being stolen this holiday season:

- Require a signature with all package delivery.
- If you won't be home, have the company leave the package at a local shipping center.
- If UPS is making the delivery, sign up online for their U.P.S. My Choice program, which sends an e-mail or text message to the customer just prior to package arrival. The package will be rerouted if nobody is home.
- Retrieve your mail as quickly as possible after delivery.
- If you can't retrieve your mail daily, have a trusted person collect it.
- If you're traveling, have the post office hold your mail until you get back.
- Never leave packages outside your door.
- Insure any packages you send.

If a package is stolen, please contact your local postmaster or nearest Postal Inspector to file a formal complaint.

#### **Scam Alerts**

There have been a number of scam attempts reported by members lately. Some people have received calls from people claiming to be from the IRS and asking for personal information. The IRS only contacts taxpayers by mail, they do not contact people by phone. If you receive a call from the IRS or from someone claiming to be from your bank or credit card company do not give out any personal information. If possible, ask for a phone number and the name of the person and then call the bank, or credit company yourself using a number on the card or looking up the bank phone number. You can ask if they have been trying to reach you, and if that person works there. You can also request that information be sent to you by mail before responding to any questions, or giving out information. If you have any doubts, please call the GV office and we will work with you to figure out if a call or information request was legitimate.
